Week 1 (Jan. 4 – 11)

Category: Our Relationship to God #1: Sin (Guilt)

Isaiah 64:6: For all of us have become like one who is unclean, And all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; And all of us wither like a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

Jeremiah 17:9: "The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?"

Romans 3:10: as it is written, "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE;

Week 2 (Jan. 11 – 18)

Category: Our Relationship to God #2: Forgiveness (Repentance)

Psalm 32 :5 I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I did not hide; I said, " I will confess my transgressions to the LORD"; And You forgave the guilt of my sin. Selah.

1 John 1 :9-10 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar and His word is not in us.

Week 3 (Jan. 18 – 25)

Category: Our Relationship to God #3: God's Love

1 John 4 :9 By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.

Romans 5 :7-8 For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3 :16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Week 4 (Jan. 25 – Feb. 1)

Category: Our Relationship to God #4: Salvation

Romans 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Acts 4:12 And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Category: Our Relationship to God #5: Worship/Praise (1)

Hebrews 13:15 Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His name.

Psalm 29:2 Ascribe to the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in holy array.

John 4:23-4 But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

Category: Our Relationship to God #6: Worship/Praise (2)

Matthew 4:10 Then Jesus said to him, "Go, Satan! For it is written, 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD, AND SERVE HIM ONLY' "

Psalm 143:10 Teach me to do Your will, For You are my God; Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground.

John 16:13 But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends.

1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

Mark 12:31 The second is this, `YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.' There is no other commandment greater than these.

BUT IF YOUR ENEMY IS HUNGRY, FEED HIM, AND IF HE IS THIRSTY, GIVE HIM A DRINK; FOR IN SO DOING YOU WILL HEAP BURNING COALS ON HIS HEAD." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Luke 6:31 Treat others the same way you want them to treat you.

Category: Our Relationships With Others #7: Anger (1)

1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.

James 1:19-20 This you know, my beloved brethren. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger; for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God.

Psalms 37:8 Cease from anger and forsake wrath; Do not fret; it leads only to evildoing.

Romans 13 :13 Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy.

The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever.

Colossians 3:5,8,9 Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry. But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth. Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices

Category: Personal Guidelines #4: Godliness

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Ephesians 4:22-24 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

1 Peter 1:15 but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior
